**BACKGROUND/COMMUNITY BENEFITS:** In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the County and its inhabitants therefore a benefit results to the County.

The Board of Supervisors is being asked once again to approve appropriations to help fund the *Auburn Aviation Association*. The Auburn Aviation Association is constructing a public park structure at the Auburn Airport. It will have a view of the runways and will provide an area where the public can enjoy activities at the airport in the shade. The project began in 2007 and has been well supported by materials and labor from individuals and local business's. The funds designated towards the association will assist the organization in finalizing this project.

Dear Supervisor Holmes,

The Auburn Aviation Association is constructing a public park at the Auburn Airport. It will have a view of the runways and will provide an area where the public can enjoy activities at the Auburn Airport in the shade. The Project began in 2007 when we started a fund drive to secure donations of time and money from local businesses and individuals. To date we have raised over \$8,000 in donations.

The main items of construction are: under grounding an existing power line, constructing a large sunshade which is almost complete and landscaping the park area. We are planning a work day on September 27, 2008 to install the roof on the sunshade. A local Eagle Scout is going to do the landscaping as his Eagle Scout Project later this year using volunteer labor and materials.

Our goal was to have the sunshade completed so the public could have a place in the shade to view the August Auburn Air Fair. Many people took advantage of the sunshade during the Air Fair.

I request \$250 from the Board of Supervisor's Revenue Sharing Funds to complete our funding of the Project. The Auburn Aviation Association is a non profit organization and our Tax ID number is: 86-0083066.

This is a project for the public use and has very well supported by materials and labor from individuals and local business's as evidenced by the over \$8,000 in donations. A \$250 donation from The Board of Supervisor's Revenue Sharing Funds will complete funding for the park and will be greatly appreciated.

I have enclosed two photos of the park, one of the sunshade structure and the other looking out toward the runway from the park Area.
