SUBJECT: Approve the appointment of Jim McCauley to continue serving as Placer County's representative on the Department of Justice, Electronic Recording Delivery Act (ERDA) Advisory Committee.

ACTION REQUESTED

Approve the appointment of Jim McCauley to continue serving as Placer County's representative on the Department of Justice, Electronic Recording Delivery Act (ERDA) Advisory Committee.

BACKGROUND

Assembly Bill 578 established the Electronic Recording Deliver Act (ERDA). This Act authorizes a county recorder, upon approval by resolution of the board of supervisors, to establish an electronic recording delivery system for recording specified digitized and digital electronic records.

The ERDA, via AB 578, is developing regulations for the Electronic Recording Delivery System Program and Jim McCauley currently serves as a representative for Placer County on the Advisory Committee. Mr. McCauley serves with 14 other representatives from organizations such as the Recorders Association; National Notary Association; California Land Title Association; Department of Justice; California Bankers Association; California Mortgage Bankers Association; California Realtors Association; the Title Association and the IT Security Industry.

The duties of the Advisory Committee Members are to provide insight, direction, program definition, consultation in the drafting of regulations, and to facilitate the exchange of information between the Advisory Committee and the agency/industry they represent.

The Board is being asked to continue the appointment of Jim McCauley as representative for Placer County on the ERDA Advisory Committee.

FISCAL IMPACT

Advisory Committee representatives serve without compensation or reimbursement for travel, per diem, or other expenses.
