BACKGROUND/COMMUNITY BENEFITS

Richard Roccucci, PE, has been a lifelong resident of Roseville and has dedicated 36 years as a public servant committed to the betterment of the City of Roseville in Placer County. He attended UC Berkeley to achieve his BS and MS in Electrical Engineering and served in the US Air Force for 5 years. He began his journey in public service in 1977 after being appointed to the Planning Commission by the Roseville City Council. Since then, he has dedicated countless hours to serving the residents and community of Roseville. He served a total of 16 years on the Roseville City Council. This Commendation is being presented in honor of Richard's dedication and contributions towards the betterment of Roseville.

Whereas, Richard Roccucci is a lifelong resident of Roseville. He and his wife Pauline have been married for 39 years and have four children and four grandchildren all living in Roseville; and

Whereas, Richard graduated from Roseville High School and from Sierra College in Rocklin and attended the University of California, Berkley where he achieved his BS and MS degrees in Electrical Engineering; and

Whereas, Richard served in the United States Air Force for five years as an Electronics Engineer before returning home to Roseville; and

Whereas, he worked in the private sector for over 37 years performing a multitude of electrical engineering assignments for companies like Pacific Bell; AC Systems Engineering; Nextel Communications; Telecom Plus; SBC and CES Engineering Inc ; and

Whereas, Richard began his journey with public service in 1972 as a Planning Commissioner appointed by the Roseville City Council and served as a Commissioner until 1977; and

Whereas, in 1977, Richard was elected as a Roseville City Councilmember where he served until 1985 including being Mayor from 1982-1984; and

Whereas, Richard also served on the Roseville Project Review Commission from 1974 – 1977; the Roseville Utility Commission from 1986 – 1989; the Roseville City School District as a Trustee from 1990 – 1998 and as Roseville City Councilmember from 2000 to 2008 retiring from the Council in December of 2008; and

Whereas, throughout his career as a public servant he has been a member or commissioner on multiple committees and organizations such as the Northern California Power Agency; Economic Development Committee; Placer Flood Control and Conservation District; South Placer Waste Water Authority; Central Roseville Revitalization Committee; Historic District Revitalization Committee; the Highway 65 Bypass Committee; Route 102 (now Placer Expressway) Committee; the Sacramento Area Council of Governments (SACOG) and the Placer County Local Area Formation Commission (LAFCO). His service on each of these committees and commissions has been invaluable towards shaping Roseville's future and throughout the development of Roseville over the past 36 years.
