**ACTION REQUESTED**

Approve the attached ordinance correcting Placer County Code, Chapter 3, Section 3.12.010, Appendix 3-DSAS, Appendix 4-DSAN, and Appendix MGTS-9, effective February 13, 2009, 5:01p.m.

**BACKGROUND**

On February 24, 2009, your Board approved Ordinance 5545-B which implements the Measure F salary changes as was discussed in the staff memo to your Board. It has been discovered that a miscalculation occurred in the salary step, hourly rates. The attached ordinance corrects the salary step, hourly rates to be reflective of the percentage increases approved by your Board on February 24, 2009.

**FISCAL IMPACT**

The total cost impact, approximately \$569,135 (\$1,654,342 annualized), was correctly included in the original Board item, therefore there is no fiscal impact of this ordinance correction beyond that which had already been approved by your Board on February 24, 2009.
