ACTION REQUESTED / RECOMMENDATION

Approve the project plans and specifications for use in bidding and construction of the Squaw Valley Bus Shelter and authorize the Department to advertise for bids.

BACKGROUND / SUMMARY

The Squaw Valley Bus Shelter is located in front of the Clock Tower in Squaw Valley at the existing bus stop.

The current facility is an open air waiting area. This particular bus stop receives a great deal of use and needs to be improved to provide a safer better waiting area that allows patrons an area to wait for the bus inside any protected area during inclement weather.

The proposed construction will improve existing transit facilities by providing patrons protection from inclement weather while waiting for the bus. The improvements will also include a ramp so that the shelter is accessible to all users.

ENVIRONMENTAL

This project is categorically exempt from the provisions of CEQA under the following sections: Section 15301, Existing Facilities, Class 1; Section 15303, New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures Class 3.

FISCAL IMPACT

The total project cost is estimated to be \$65,000 with construction costs estimated at \$50,000. The project is fully funded through grants from the North Lake Tahoe Resort Association. Funding for the construction of this project is included in the Fiscal Year 2009-10 Budget.
