SUBJECT: Ratify the Rejection of all Bid Responses to Competitive Bid No. 9907 for Security and Support Services for Health and Human Services Programs at Sutter Roseville Medical Center

ACTION REQUESTED

Ratify the rejection of all bid responses to competitive Bid No. 9907 for security and support services for Health and Human Services programs at Sutter Roseville Medical Center.

BACKGROUND

The Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) required an annual contract with a security firm to provide security and support services for individuals on a Section 5150 hold, while at the Sutter Roseville Medical Center (SRMC). Section 5150 is a section of the California Welfare and Institutions Code which allows a qualified officer or clinician to involuntarily confine a person deemed to have a mental disorder that makes him or her a danger to himself or herself and/or others, or is gravely disabled. Persons are currently medically cleared and assessed under this Code at SRMC. Seventeen vendors were notified by e-mail of Invitation for Bid (IFB) No. 9907, which was available on the County e-Bid system. One addendum was issued for this bid. Six bid responses were received.

During the bid evaluation process, HHS notified Procurement Services that security and support services to be provided by the County at SRMC were no longer required; SRMC decided to provide its own security. As a result, all bid responses were rejected. This action now requires your Board's ratification.

FISCAL IMPACT

This action will not result in an expenditure of funds.
