SUBJECT: AUBURN FOLSOM ROAD WIDENING; MIDDLE PHASE CONSTRUCTION
CONTRACT NO. 1073

ACTION REQUESTED / RECOMMENDATION

Adopt a Resolution approving the project plans and specifications, authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign the cover sheet, and authorize the Department of Public Works to advertise for bids and to sign the improvement plans for the Auburn Folsom Road Widening, Middle Phase Project.

BACKGROUND / SUMMARY

This construction contract is for the Middle Phase of the Auburn Folsom Road Widening project. The ultimate project will widen Auburn Folsom Road from two lanes to four lanes from Fuller Drive to the County Line to handle rapidly increasing traffic between the Folsom area, Granite Bay, and Roseville. The City of Folsom has constructed a corresponding widening south of the County Line to Folsom Dam Road. Completion of these two projects will create a four-lane roadway from Douglas Blvd. to Highway 50. The County's project has been divided into three phases: North Phase (Douglas Blvd. to approximately 1500' south of Eureka Road), South Phase (County Line to approximately 1500' north of Oak Hill Drive) completed June 2009 and Middle Phase (1500' north of Oak Hill Drive to 1500' south of Eureka Road). Also, as a smaller phase of this project, a signal was installed at Auburn-Folsom Road and Fuller Drive in 2006.

The proposed improvements for the Construction of the Middle Phase include: widen Auburn-Folsom Road to 4 lanes from the Woodchase Drive to 1500' south of Eureka Road, construct drainage improvements and replace the San Juan Water District water line through the project area; Construction is expected to begin in late Summer 2009 and will take two construction seasons to complete.

ENVIRONMENTAL

The Board of Supervisors certified and approved the Final Environmental Impact Report with findings on June 22, 2004.

FISCAL IMPACT

The construction cost for the Middle Phase is estimated at \$7,900,000; approximately \$860,000 will be reimbursed by San Juan Water District for the work related to replacing their water line. The Middle Phase is partially funded by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) (\$2,068,237) with the remainder funded by Traffic Mitigation Fees from the Granite Bay Trust Fund (\$4,972,000). There are sufficient funds available in the 09/10 Fiscal Year budget for this work.




