SUBJECT: Approve the Renewal of Competitively Awarded Blanket Purchase Order No. BP016253 with Rite Aid Corporation for Local Pharmacy Services in the Maximum Amount of \$75,000.00

ACTION REQUESTED

Approve the renewal of competitively awarded Blanket Purchase Order (BPO) No. 16253 with Rite Aid Corporation of Camp Hill, PA, for local pharmacy services in the maximum amount of \$75,000.00, and authorize the Purchasing Manager to sign the resulting BPO.

BACKGROUND

On October 21, 2008, your Board approved the second renewal BPO with Rite Aid Corporation as a result of competitive Bid No. 9606 for local pharmacy services and authorized the Purchasing Manager to sign the resulting BP016253 in the maximum amount of \$75,000.00 on behalf of the Department of Health & Human Services Medical Care Services Program.

The Department of Health & Human Services has requested to renew BP016253 and Rite Aid Corporation has agreed to renew for another year at the same pricing and terms as their original bid. Section 17 of the General Terms and Conditions of Bid No. 9606 allows the County the option to renew the contract on a year-to-year basis pending satisfactory negotiation of the renewal pricing, terms, and conditions.

FISCAL IMPACT

The BPO resulting from this recommendation will total \$75,000.00 and will be effective from October 1, 2009 through September 30, 2010. The Department of Health & Human Services' Fiscal Impact Statement is attached.

The department has budgeted appropriately for the renewal of this \$75,000 Blanket Purchase Order (BPO) and funding for the first nine months is available in the Proposed FY2009-2010 Budget. The final three months of the BPO will be included in the FY2010-2011 Budget. The renewal amount is the same as the current BPO in place with Rite Aid Corporation. Pharmaceutical services are provided to eligible recipients in the County's mandated Medical Care Services Program, which is funded 100% by the County General Fund.
