SUBJECT: AUBURN-FOLSOM ROAD WIDENING MIDDLE PHASE PROJECT,
AUTHORIZATION FOR AWARD OF CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT

ACTION REQUESTED / RECOMMENDATION

Adopt a Resolution authorizing the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors to award and execute the construction contract, with County Counsel and Risk Management review and approval, for the Auburn-Folsom Road Widening Middle Phase Project, to the lowest responsible and responsive bidder, Western Engineering, for \$4,297,070.25, and authorize the Director of Public Works to execute contract change orders up to 10% of the contract amount.

BACKGROUND / SUMMARY

Public Works is proposing to construct the Middle Phase of Auburn-Folsom Road Widening Project. The proposed improvements for the Construction of the Middle Phase include: widen Auburn-Folsom Road to 4 lanes from 1500' north of the Oak Hill Drive intersection to 1500' south of the Eureka Road intersection and replace the San Juan Water District water line through the project area. Construction will begin in the spring of 2010 and will take two construction seasons to complete.

Bid Opening occurred on October 29, 2009 at 3:30 pm. There were nine bidders with bids ranging from \$4,297,070.25 up to \$5,919,365.00. We are seeking authorization from the Board for the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors to award the contract to Western Engineering whose low bid in the amount of \$4,297,070.25 was the lowest responsive and responsible bid.

ENVIRONMENTAL

The Board of Supervisors certified and approved the Final Environmental Impact Report with findings on June 22, 2004. A Notice of Determination was filed on June 25, 2004. The Finding of No Significant Impact was approved on January 11, 2005 and remains valid. Caltrans concurred with the NEPA conclusion for the Middle Phase project and provided approval and re-validation on July 7, 2009.

FISCAL IMPACT

The cost for the construction contract for the Middle Phase is \$4,297,070.25; approximately \$760,000 will be reimbursed by San Juan Water District for the work related to replacing their water line. The Middle Phase is partially funded by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) with the remainder funded by Traffic Mitigation Fees from the Granite Bay Trust Fund. There are sufficient funds available in the 09/10 Fiscal Year budget for this work.



Works to execute contract change orders up to 10% of the contract amount.


**AUBURN-FOLSOM ROAD WIDENING, MIDDLE PHASE
