SUBJECT: Recommendation to Declare Vehicles and Miscellaneous Equipment as Surplus and Authorize Disposal by Public Sale

RECOMMENDATION

Declare vehicles and miscellaneous equipment listed on Attachment A as surplus and authorize their sale.

BACKGROUND

Procurement has received a list of vehicles and equipment which the Department of Public Works (DPW) Fleet Operations and Roads, the Sheriff's Department, the Facility Services Department, and the Health and Human Services Department have identified as having reached the end of their useful life cycle. The Public Guardian has also requested to include one vehicle in the sale. The complete inventory of vehicles and equipment is shown on Attachment A. Certain lower mileage vehicles on the list are being disposed of because they are unreliable or too costly to repair. The vehicles and equipment have been removed from service by all applicable departments and divisions.

The County has a contract with Roger Ernst & Associates of Modesto for auctioneering services. The contract requires the auctioneer to pick up the County's surplus vehicles, equipment, and miscellaneous surplus items in the surplus warehouse and sell it at the contractor's auction yard.

Section 2.1 (i) of the Purchasing Policy Manual requires your Board's approval of surplus declarations that exceed \$2,500.00. While the eventual auction bid for some of the equipment may not meet that threshold, we cannot determine the auction bids in advance, so all items with the potential to exceed \$2,500 are included.

FISCAL IMPACT

This action generates revenue which will be used by the County for future vehicle and equipment purchases. Roger Ernst charges a 4.75 percent commission on the proceeds from the sale of vehicles and miscellaneous equipment. The previous surplus sale approved by your Board on May 12, 2009 resulted in net proceeds of \$90,309.61 to Placer County.
