SUBJECT: **Approve a Resolution authorizing the execution of a Service Provider Subgrant from the Golden Sierra Job Training Agency in the amount of \$82,600 to provide Layoff Aversion Services to Businesses in Placer County, approve a Budget Revision, and Authorize the County Executive Officer to execute any related documents or contracts**

ACTION REQUESTED

1. Approve a Resolution authorizing the execution of a Service Provider Subgrant from the Golden Sierra Job Training Agency in the amount \$82,600 to provide Business Assistance, Layoff Aversion Services, and Employee Retention Services in Placer County.
2. Approve a Budget Revision.
3. Authorize the County Executive Officer to execute any related documents or contracts.

BACKGROUND

The Golden Sierra Job Training Agency has awarded \$82,600 in funding provided by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 to Placer County. "Vital Assets" funding will provide business assistance, layoff aversion, and employee retention services from July 1, 2009 to June 30, 2010. GSJTA has set aside \$82,600 in a Service Provider Subgrant for the Placer County Office of Economic Development and the Business Advantage Network (BAN) to use these funds to maintain and establish relationships with businesses in the region by providing:

Layoff Aversion Services - by developing action plans to identify and assist employers at risk of layoff due to competitive factors and establishing partnerships to gather information on changing workforce needs due to changes in the regional/local economy;

Innovation - supporting innovative efforts to expand or redesign local Rapid Response systems to become more responsive to local businesses;

Business Services - by creating new ways to bring the One-Stop Career Center System to the employer; and

Regional Impact - by supporting efforts to share innovative Rapid Response Service Models with the GSJTA and through the Workforce Investment Act and Capitol Area Investment Zone Region.

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ENVIRONMENT REVIEW

This action is exempt from CEQA Guidelines Section 15262 & 15306.

FISCAL IMPACT

These expenditures will be fully reimbursed by revenues so there will be no impact to the General Fund. HHS will provide increased CalWorks funding in an amount equal to the grant to offset a General Fund contribution received in FY 2009-10.


