SUBJECT: Authorize the Registrar of Voters to Render Election Services for Elections to be held June 8, 2010

Recommendation

Approve the attached resolution authorizing the Placer County Registrar of Voters to render election services for the federal, state, county and local district elections to be held June 8, 2010

Background

Pursuant to federal and state law and the Placer County charter, certain federal, state, and county elections are to be conducted by this office on the first Tuesday in June each even-numbered year

Additionally, Election Code Section 10002 and Education Code Section 5303 provide that special district and school district Governing Bodies may request the Board of Supervisors to order their elections and permit the County Registrar of Voters to render the necessary election services to the requesting districts on a reimbursable basis. For the Registrar to perform the functions pursuant to Election Code Section 10002 and Education Code Section 5303, approval by the Board of Supervisors is required.

Please see attached 'Exhibit A' for the full list of federal, state and local jurisdictions in Placer County requiring or requesting election services for the June 8, 2010 election. Only the election for the Sacramento County Board of Education Trustee Area 2, which overlaps a small portion into Placer County, has been requested as a local district election to be conducted by Placer for the upcoming June election.

Fiscal Impact

The requesting local jurisdiction will pay for their proportionate share of election costs as set forth in the approved fee schedule for election services. The balance of election costs are a County General Fund responsibility, except for that portion of vote-by-mail (absentee ballot) costs which are reimbursable as state mandated costs under SB 90. Adequate funding for the June 8, 2010 election has been included in the FY 2010-11 adopted Final Budget.
