Subject: **AWARD OF BID – NEW VEHICLE EXHAUST SYSTEM AT DRY CREEK FIRE STATION NO. 100 , PROJECT NO. 4817A**

ACTION REQUESTED / RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that your Board award the bid for the New Vehicle Exhaust System at Dry Creek Fire Station No. 100, Project No. 4817A to Callison Construction, Inc., in the amount of \$79,870 and upon approval of County Counsel and Risk Management, authorize the Director of Facility Services to execute a contract and any required change orders consistent with the County Purchasing Manual and Section 20142 of the Public Contract Code.

BACKGROUND: On January 12, 2010, your Board approved plans and specifications and authorized the director of Facility Services to award a contract up to an amount, not to exceed, \$69,800 for this project. Bid solicitations were advertised in accordance with the Public Contract Code. Bid documents were sent to five (5) specialty trade contractors and eight (8) building exchanges. Bids were opened by Procurement Services on February 4, 2010, resulting in the one (1) bid listed in the attached Bid Tabulation Sheet (Attachment A). The apparent low bidder is Callison Construction, Inc., from Elk Grove, CA, with a base bid of \$79,870.

The bid came in higher than the amount previously authorized by your Board; therefore we are requesting your Board award the bid pursuant to the Purchasing Policy Manual and authorize the Director of Facility Services to execute a contract with Callison Construction, Inc., in the amount of \$79,870.

ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE: This project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to Section 15301 – that provides for operation, repair, maintenance, or minor alteration of existing structures or facilities not expanding existing uses.

FISCAL IMPACT: The total project cost of the Dry Creek Fire Station No. 100 Apparatus Bay project is estimated to be \$864,226, including \$79,870 for construction of the New Vehicle Exhaust System. There is sufficient funding appropriated in the Capital Projects Fund for the New Vehicle Exhaust System project. As previously indicated, staff will return to your Board with recommendations concerning proceeding with the balance of the project when additional funding is identified.
