SUBJECT: Approve the Renewal of Blanket Purchase Order No. 16628 as a Result of Competitive Bid No. 9542 with Allied Environmental, Inc. for Asbestos Abatement Services in the Maximum Amount of \$95,000.00

ACTION REQUESTED

Approve the renewal of Blanket Purchase Order (BPO) No. 16628 as a result of competitive Bid No. 9542 with Allied Environmental, Inc. of Shingle Springs, California, for asbestos abatement services in the maximum amount of \$95,000.00, and authorize the Purchasing Manager to sign the resulting blanket purchase order.

BACKGROUND

Facility Services requires a contract for asbestos abatement services on an as-needed basis. On April 4, 2006, your Board awarded Bid No. 9542 to Allied Environmental. The BPO was renewed for three consecutive one-year terms at the original bid pricing. The current BPO, BP016628, expires on March 31, 2010. The Department of Facility Services has requested to renew the BPO for another year in the amount of \$95,000.00. Allied Environmental has agreed to renew again at the original bid pricing. Staff recommends renewal in accordance with the Purchasing Policy Manual, Section 1.3(o), based on satisfactory service and reasonable prices. This will be the fourth and final renewal of Bid No. 9542.

FISCAL IMPACT

The BPO resulting from this recommendation will total \$95,000.00 and will be effective from April 1, 2010 through March 31, 2011. The Department of Facility Services' Fiscal Impact Statement is attached.
