The North Tahoe Regional Advisory Council, composed of nine members who live and work in the Placer County area of Tahoe, is the local advisory body to the Placer County Board of Supervisors. At its February 11, 2010 meeting, the Council considered Zoning Text Amendment ZTA 20090393, Medical Marijuana Collectives, Cooperatives or Dispensaries and voted as follows:

The Council approved unanimously a motion to deny the recommendation of the proposed Zoning Text Amendment that will define and disallow medical marijuana collectives, cooperatives or dispensaries to operate in Placer County and further to clarify that the production and composting of cannabis is not included in the definition of "Crop Production" or "Agricultural Processing" within the existing County Code.

The Council approved (with one abstention) a motion recommending that the Placer County Board of Supervisors: (1) disallow the document known as "Zoning Text Amendment 20090393, Medical Marijuana Collectives, Cooperatives or Dispensaries" because the results were predetermined by a staff directive; (2) reject the Planning Commission report based on the above-mentioned skewed report; and (3) to direct staff to start over on researching the Medical Marijuana Collectives, Cooperatives, or Dispensaries, beginning with inclusive community input, proper research, and comparative studies of like-businesses, and to bring these results back through the proper channels of the Municipal Advisory Councils for further discussion.
