SUBJECT: **HIGHWAY 49 DIAL-A-RIDE CONTRACT No. 20543, AMENDMENT 4**

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## **ACTION REQUESTED / RECOMMENDATION**

Adopt a Resolution authorizing the Director of Public Works to execute, with County Counsel and Risk Management's review and approval, Amendment No. 4 to Contract No. 20543 with PRIDE Industries to remove the requirement of a General Public Paratransit Vehicle (GPPV) certification for the remainder of this contract, including any future extensions.

## **BACKGROUND / SUMMARY**

PRIDE Industries operates the Highway 49 Dial-A-Ride under contract with Placer County. The Highway 49 Dial-A-Ride provides demand response transit service in the Highway 49 corridor between Dry Creek Road and downtown Auburn. The service area is three quarters of a mile on both sides of the Placer County Transit (PCT) fixed route. The Highway 49 Dial-A-Ride meets the paratransit requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).

The purpose of the contract amendment is to remove a requirement in the contract that has been negated by the purchase of County owned vehicles for this service. In the California Vehicle Code, Section 336, paragraph 3 it is stated that; "A vehicle that provides local transportation to the general public through one of the following modes: dial-a-ride, subscription service, or route deviated bus service, but does not provide transportation of pupils at or below the 12<sup>th</sup>-grade level to or from a public or private school or school activity, is a transit bus, as defined by section 642, and is not a general public paratransit vehicle." All other contract provisions will remain the same as the original contract, including the ability to change service levels if necessary.

## **ENVIRONMENTAL**

The project is statutorily exempt from CEQA pursuant to section 21080(b)(10), as it is a project to provide passenger service.

## **FISCAL IMPACT**

This action will not accrue any additional costs to this contract. In future contract negotiations a moderate cost savings may be realized due to reduced vehicle maintenance charges.
