SUBJECT: SOUTH PLACER DIAL-A-RIDE CONTRACT No. 12530, AMENDMENT 2

ACTION REQUESTED / RECOMMENDATION

Adopt a Resolution authorizing the Director of Public Works to execute, with County Counsel and Risk Management's review and approval, Amendment No. 2 to Contract No. 12530 with PRIDE Industries to remove the requirement of a General Public Paratransit Vehicle (GPPV) certification for the remainder of this contract, including any future extensions.

BACKGROUND / SUMMARY

PRIDE Industries provides the South Placer Dial-A-Ride and Taylor Road Shuttle under Contract to Placer County. PRIDE provides three services: 1) Dial-A-Ride service in the Loomis and Rocklin area; 2) Dial-A-Ride service in Granite Bay; and, 3) a deviated route shuttle on Taylor Road between Auburn and Sierra College. These services meet the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements for accessible paratransit services, as well as, provide service in areas where there are no PCT bus routes.

The purpose of the contract amendment is to remove a requirement in the contract that has been negated by the purchase of County owned vehicles for this service. In the California Vehicle Code, Section 336, paragraph 3 it is stated that; "A vehicle that provides local transportation to the general public through one of the following modes: dial-a-ride, subscription service, or route deviated bus service, but does not provide transportation of pupils at or below the 12th-grade level to or from a public or private school or school activity, is a transit bus, as defined by section 642, and is not a general public paratransit vehicle." All other contract provisions will remain the same as the original contract, including the ability to change service levels if necessary.

ENVIRONMENTAL

The project is statutorily exempt from CEQA pursuant to section 21080(b)(10), as it is a project to provide passenger service.

FISCAL IMPACT

This action will not accrue any additional costs to this contract. In future contract negotiations a moderate cost savings may be realized due to reduced vehicle maintenance charges.
