

BACKGROUND/COMMUNITY BENEFITS: In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the County and its inhabitants therefore a benefit results to the County.

The Board of Supervisors is being asked to approve appropriations to help fund the Lincoln Community Foundation annual *Night at the Pavilion* being held Friday, September 3. The Lincoln Community Foundation is dedicated to assisting not-for-profit organizations in Lincoln to help with projects that work with children and others for the betterment of the Lincoln community.
