BACKGROUND/COMMUNITY BENEFITS: In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the County and its inhabitants therefore a benefit results to the County.

The Board of Supervisors is being asked to approve appropriations to help support the Ride to Walk *Annual Boots and Scoots BBQ and Barn Dance* being held October 9. Ride to Walk is a local therapeutic riding program for children and adults with neurological disabilities such as Autism, Cerebral Palsy and Muscular Dystrophy. 
Dear Business Owner and Community Partner,
