ACTION REQUESTED

Approve appropriation of \$5,000 in Revenue Sharing monies to the *Tommy Apostolos Fund* to benefit Roseville children in need, as requested by Supervisor Rockholm (\$5,000).

BACKGROUND/COMMUNITY BENEFITS: In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the County and its inhabitants therefore a benefit results to the County.

The Board of Supervisors is being asked to approve appropriations to help support the *Tommy Apostolos Fund*. In 1988, in memory of Tommy Apostolos, the Apostolos Family, Roseville Police, Roseville Telephone and Roseville Elementary Schools joined together to take ten needy children shopping in Roseville. This program has grown to serve over five hundred children from the Roseville School Districts each year. For over twenty years the Tommy Apostolos Fund has provided warm winter clothing, school clothes, and backpacks to needy children in the Roseville Community. The funds designated towards this popular event will benefit Roseville children in need.

For over 20 years the Tommy Apostolos Fund has provided warm winter clothing, school clothes, and backpacks to needy children in the Roseville Community.

Tommy Apostolos was a longtime Roseville resident who cared deeply about the happiness and wellbeing of children in our community. When he died in 1988, his family received donations which provided clothing for 10 children. Since 1988, the fund has grown to the point of clothing over 500 Roseville school-aged children annually who shop at Kohl's in Roseville with hundreds of community volunteers.
