**Subject:** Specialized equipment grant from the Department of Boating and Waterways

**BOARD ACTION REQUESTED**

Your Board is requested to Accept a grant from California Department of Boating and Waterways in the amount of \$26,500, approve a budget revision to purchase a Remote Operated Vehicle (ROV) Spooling system; add the equipment to the Master Fixed Asset List; and authorize Edward N. Bonner, Sheriff-Coroner-Marshal to execute contract documents related to the grant, and for the Purchasing Manager to execute any purchasing documents related to this equipment including the determination of sole source purchase. There is no impact to the General Fund.

**BACKGROUND**

The State Department of Boating and Waterways has specialized equipment grants available to eligible boating and waterway programs to support and enhance boating safety and law enforcement on waterways. A proposal was submitted to them in the amount \$26,500 to purchase a ROV Spooling system. This system consists of a electric spooling system that allows for a quicker, more reliable casting and retrieving operation for the ROV. This equipment will supplement our current ROV system which is used for recovering vessels or bodies in water too deep for normal recovery by divers. The Sheriff's Department has been notified that we have been awarded \$26,500 to purchase this system. This equipment purchase must be completed no later than September 1, 2011.

The Department of Boating and Waterways requires the grant contract to be approved by the Board of Supervisors as well as specific authorization for the Sheriff to execute the grant contract documents. A minute order affixed with the County's seal must be certified by the Clerk of the Board and accompany the executed contract. Failure to comply with these provisions will result in the grant contract disapproval. Your Board's approval is also requested for the addition of the equipment to the Master Fixed Asset List, the budget revision (Attachment A) and the Purchasing Manager to execute any related purchasing documents including the determination of sole source purchase of this equipment.

**FISCAL IMPACT**

The budget revision will increase the Marine Patrol Grant Program expenditures and revenue in the amount of \$26,500. There is no impact to the General Fund.
