SUBJECT: Approve the Renewal of Two Blanket Purchase Orders Awarded from a Competitively Bid Public Agency Cooperative Agreement with Auburn Tire Service and Schultz Tire Factory for Passenger Car, Truck, and Heavy Equipment Tires in the Maximum Aggregate Amount of \$255,000.00

ACTION REQUESTED

Approve the renewal of two blanket purchase orders (BPOs) awarded from a competitively bid public agency cooperative contract with Auburn Tire Service and Schultz Tire Factory for passenger car, truck, and heavy equipment tires in the maximum aggregate amount of \$255,000.00, and authorize the Purchasing Manager to sign the resulting BPOs and to transfer funds between the BPOs as necessary to meet the County's needs.

BACKGROUND

The Department of Public Works Fleet Services Division (DPW) has requested to renew BP017297 with Auburn Tire Service and BP017308 with Schultz Tire Factory for the as-needed purchase of passenger car, truck, and heavy equipment tires utilizing a competitively bid Western States Contracting Alliance (WSCA) contract. The State of Utah, on behalf of WSCA, awarded three contracts for tires, inner tubes, and services to Bridgestone Americas, Goodyear Tire & Rubber Company, and Michelin North America, which are in effect through February 28, 2012. The State of California signed a participating addendum for each WSCA contract which allows Placer County to purchase these products at the WSCA contract pricing.

Auburn Tire Service and Schultz Tire Factory have both agreed to honor the WSCA contract pricing for the purchase of Bridgestone, Goodyear, and Michelin brand tires for the upcoming renewal period. Purchasing Policy Manual (PPM) Section 1.3 (e)(3) permits contracting with a vendor that was awarded an agreement by another public agency as the result of a competitive process without further competitive bidding by Placer County.

FISCAL IMPACT

Upon your Board's approval, BPOs will be awarded to Auburn Tire Service and Schultz Tire Factory each in the maximum amount of \$127,500.00 and will be effective January 1, 2011, through February 28, 2012 to expire concurrently with the WSCA contract's expiration date. DPW's Fiscal Impact Statement is attached.
