

Subject: 2010/11 SEWER LINE VIDEO INSPECTION, SMD 1 AND SMD 2 -
PROJECT 08239

ACTION REQUESTED/RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends that your Board adopt the attached Resolution authorizing the Director of Facility Services to execute a contract with Coastline Water Resources for the 2010/11 Sewer Line Video Inspection, Sewer Maintenance District (SMD) 1 and SMD 2 – Project 08239, in an amount not to exceed \$210,696, upon review and approval by Risk Management and County Counsel, and approve any required change orders consistent with the County Purchasing Manual and Section 20142 of the Public Contract Code.

BACKGROUND: On January 27, 2009, your Board approved a list of prequalified firms to perform sewer line video inspections for sewer collection systems throughout the County. On December 13, 2010, staff solicited cost proposals for sewer line video inspection work in SMD 1 and SMD 2 from the four firms on the prequalified list with the intention of entering into a contract with the responsive firm with the lowest cost proposal. Three (3) cost proposals were returned and Coastline Water Resources provided the lowest cost for the work with a bid of \$210,696 (SMD 1 - \$122,555 and SMD 2 - \$88,141). The Engineer's Estimate for this work is \$221,196.

The project includes hydro cleaning and video inspection of approximately 78,370 linear feet of sanitary sewer lines within SMD 1 in the North Auburn area, and 57,094 linear feet in SMD 2 in the Granite Bay area. The goal of the sewer line video inspection is to locate ground water infiltrating into the sewer collection system and to identify repair projects that will minimize this infiltration. The information is also used in Sanitary Sewer Management Plans required by the Regional Water Quality Control Board to develop five and ten-year Capital Improvement Programs.

In order to expedite completion of the project during the winter months, staff recommends that your Board authorize the Director of Facility Services to execute a contract with Coastline Water Resources and approve any required change orders.

ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE: Cleaning and inspection of existing sanitary sewer collection lines is categorically exempt from environmental review pursuant to Section 15301(b) "Existing Facilities" of the California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines.

FISCAL IMPACT: Coastline Water Resources' bid for the project is \$210,696. Staff recommends a total project budget of \$233,000, which includes an approximate 10% contingency. Funding for this work is available in the FY 2010/11 Budgets for SMD 1 (\$135,500) and SMD 2 (\$97,500).
