**BACKGROUND/COMMUNITY BENEFITS:** In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the County and its inhabitants therefore a benefit results to the County.

The Board of Supervisors is being asked to approve appropriations to help support Peace for Families “PEACE Survivor Run” event being held May 21. Since 1978, PEACE for Families has provided emergency shelter, counseling, education and other services annually to victims of domestic violence and sexual assault throughout Placer County. As Placer County’s Rape Crisis Center, PEACE for Families provides intervention services to victims of sexual violence by advocating for them, supporting and accompanying them from the hospital to the courtroom. The funds designated towards this organization will help defray the cost of rental equipment.

On behalf of PEACE for Families, I would like to thank you for your continued partnership in the work to end the cycle of violence in Placer County. To further this mission PEACE is planning our first annual, "PEACE Survivor Run" on May 21<sup>st</sup>, 2011. This event will help us to raise much needed funds that will go towards operating our emergency safe house, offering individual and family counseling, legal advocacy, access to emergency food and transportation, job readiness workshops and more.

We are asking that the Placer County Board of Supervisors join with PEACE to make this event a success by applying revenue sharing funds to two of our overhead items.

The first item is the rental of 4 portable toilets and one handwashing station that will be used by participants and spectators the day of the event. One of the portable toilets will have wheelchair access to insure that this event can be enjoyed by all of the citizens of Placer County. We have requested estimates from several rental companies and found Area Restroom Solutions to have the most competitive bid at \$345.00.


The second item is the purchase of racing bibs that the participants will wear during the race. The purchase of 300 bibs will cost \$150.00 and will include space to publicize our sponsors. It would be our great pleasure to include the Placer County logo on these bibs as a sign of our gratitude and mutual dedication to ending domestic violence and sexual assault.
