WHEREAS, Curtis Fong of TGFT Productions/Bike the West, applied to Caltrans for a Temporary Encroachment Permit to conduct a special bike event around Lake Tahoe called the Lake Tahoe Legends Ride; and

WHEREAS, this bike ride is co-sponsored by the Lake Tahoe Visitors Authority and the North Lake Tahoe Resort Association and is in conjunction with the Start at the Top Amgen Tour of California Start weekend at Lake Tahoe and benefits many other cycling non-profit clubs, entities and advocacy agencies in the Lake Tahoe Area as well as the community's tourism efforts; and

WHEREAS, The Lake Tahoe Legends Ride will temporarily impede and restrict the free passage of traffic over State Highway Route 89 on Saturday, May 14, 2011. Further notice is given that motor traffic from Tahoma to Tahoe City and Highway 28, Tahoe City to Crystal Bay (Nevada State Line) between the hours of 6:30am and 5:00pm will be impacted by increased bicycle traffic due to participants in the event.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Placer County Board of Supervisors goes on record in support of The Lake Tahoe Legends Ride and requests that it be conducted per the terms and conditions set forth by Caltrans in their Encroachment Permit to maintain the safety of the motoring public.
