CONTRACT NO. 1075, APPROVE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS AND
AUTHORIZATION TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS**

ACTION REQUESTED / RECOMMENDATION

Approve the project plans and specifications for use in bidding and construction of the Tahoe Pines Water Quality Improvement Project, Area A, Phase III (Ponderosa / Madrone / Poplar / Doe Avenues) and authorize the Department to advertise for bids.

BACKGROUND / SUMMARY

The Tahoe Pines Water Quality Improvement Project - Area A - Phase III (Ponderosa / Madrone / Poplar / Doe Avenues) is located on the west shore of Lake Tahoe, approximately four miles south of Tahoe City in the vicinity of the unpaved portions of Ponderosa / Madrone / Poplar / Doe Avenues.

The proposed construction, in general, includes, but is not limited to, grading, asphalt paving, culvert installation, construction of rock lined channels, energy dissipation structures, and revegetation.

The project is identified in the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency's Environmental Improvement Program (EIP) as Project EIP No. 218. The basis for this EIP project is to improve the water quality of urban storm water runoff and protect Lake Tahoe's famed water quality.

ENVIRONMENTAL

The County prepared a Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) pursuant to the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and the Placer County Environmental Review Ordinance. The MND (State Clearing House No. 2008 09 2087) was approved by the Board of Supervisors on November 25, 2008.

FISCAL IMPACT

The total project cost is estimated to be \$380,047 with an engineer's estimate of \$291,706. The project is fully funded through erosion control grants from the California Tahoe Conservancy. Funding for project construction is included in the Department's 2011-12 Fiscal Year Budget.



