ACTION REQUESTED:

The Mental Health, Alcohol, and Drug Advisory Board (MHADB) respectfully requests the Board of Supervisors approve the appointment of Patricia Reynolds-Meade as a Consumer Member for District 1, Seat 2.

BACKGROUND:

Patricia Reynolds-Meade has applied for a position on the MHADB as a consumer member. Her education includes a Masters in Human Services, a Bachelor of Arts in Criminal Justice, a Certificate in Alcohol and Drug Studies, and she is a Registered Addiction Specialist.

Ms. Reynolds-Meade has worked in the social services field for 12 years. Her experience as a program manager includes providing counseling and case management services to persons living with HIV/AIDS in an emergency housing program; substance abuse counseling to those in a mandated DUI first offenders group; mental health counseling to those with co-occurring disorders, including coordinating and providing life skills training; and as a solicitation manager, coordinating procurement of donations for the developmentally disabled.

As a consumer, Ms. Reynolds-Meade has a special interest in co-occurring disorders and assisting in goal setting for those in transitional housing. Her knowledge and experience, along with her involvement with many community service activities, will bring additional diversity to this Board. She hopes to help this Board ensure a continuum of care for those who are served and provide feedback as she learns more about the Adult and Children's Systems of Care.

The Mental Health, Alcohol, and Drug Advisory Board recommend appointment of the applicant.
