Bill gained experience and expertise in many areas within the Crimes Against Person's Unit. He is a thorough investigator, skilled interviewer and dedicated much of his career to the investigation of elder and child abuse cases.

Along with his caseload he is a POST certified criminal investigation instructor and certified forensic child interviewer for MDIC. He willingly shares his knowledge as a member of the Institute of Criminal Investigation staff. Bill has been a dedicated and loyal public servant and has been a mentor to his co-workers and the victim advocates who have worked with.
