SUBJECT: **COOPERATIVE WORK AGREEMENTS WITH THE CITY OF ROSEVILLE & CALIFORNIA AMERICAN WATER FOR THE COOK RIOLO ROAD BRIDGE REPLACEMENT AT DRY CREEK**

ACTION REQUESTED / RECOMMENDATION

Adopt two Resolutions authorizing the Director of Public Works to enter into Cooperative Work Agreements, with County Counsel and Risk Management review and approval; one Agreement with the City of Roseville (Roseville) to add a 24" water main, not to exceed \$350,000; the other Agreement with California American Water Company (CalAm) to relocate a 16" underground water line and add a future 16" water line, not to exceed \$500,000, both for the Cook Riolo Road Bridge Replacement Project.

BACKGROUND/SUMMARY

The Department of Public Works is proposing to replace the existing bridge on Cook Riolo Road over Dry Creek. The bridge structure is deteriorated and subject to frequent flooding and the roadway approaches to the bridge do not meet current standards. The project is being completed under the Federal Highway Bridge Program (HBP).

The proposed bridge and roadway approach conflicts with the existing 16" underground Cal Am water line to the extent that the line must be relocated for construction of the bridge and roadway to take place. Cal Am has requested that the County include the relocation of their water line and the construction of the new water line in the County's project at Cal Am's cost. CalAm Water has also requested that the County's consultant design the relocation and construction plans for both lines at Cal Am's cost.

The City of Roseville has requested that the County's consultant design and the County's contractor construct a future 24" water line to be placed inside the bridge at the City's cost which will improve potable water supply in the growing West Placer area.

The County, Roseville, and CalAm agree that Placer County has prior rights in both cases and Roseville will be 100% responsible for the cost of design and construction for its new water line and CalAm will be 100% responsible for the cost of design and construction for its relocated water line and new water line. The County, Roseville and CalAm have agreed that this is the most cost effective method of relocating and adding new facilities to accommodate construction at this site. Including these utility lines, with appropriate reimbursement, within the County bridge project will minimize impacts to the public, minimize future impacts to the new bridge and insure that the most cost-effective project is completed. The project is scheduled to begin construction in 2012.

ENVIRONMENTAL

The Board of Supervisors certified and approved the Initial Study / Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND) with the required findings and mitigations under CEQA on January 13, 2009. The project was granted a Categorical Exclusion under NEPA on August 27, 2008. The Professional Services Agreement is exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines, Section 15306.

FISCAL IMPACT

The requesting agencies will reimburse the County for 100% of costs associated with the water line. These resolutions authorize the Director of Public Works to enter into Work Agreements; one with the City of Roseville for an amount of \$350,000 and one with California American Water for an amount of \$500,000. The design contract for this project is for an amount not to exceed \$1,585,000. The estimated project construction cost is \$8,000,000. The project is funded through the Federal HBP Program (80-88.53%) and a combination of County Road Funds and Fee Mitigation Programs (11.47-20%). There is sufficient funding available in the FY 11/12 budget for this contract amendment.
