**ACTION REQUESTED:**

Approve Amendment CN005118-A with Latino Leadership Council, Inc. for counseling, case management, and community education, increasing the amount by \$83,902 for a revised total of \$194,865 from July 1, 2010 to June 30, 2012, and authorize the Director of Health and Human Services to sign the amendment.

**BACKGROUND:**

Since 2009, the Latino Leadership Council has been an effective partner in the delivery of culturally proficient counseling, community education and outreach to more than 4,000 Latino families in Placer County. The Council has joined with law enforcement agencies, Placer County Probation Department and key not-for-profit community partners in their shared efforts to prevent drug abuse, gang activity, and a host of other negative outcomes.

The Council's services are a part of an expanding community-based partnership which provides services to at-risk youth and have been instrumental in helping to increase school attendance and decrease entry to both child welfare and juvenile delinquency services. With these existing State and Federal dollars, the Latino Leadership Council and its partners will reach an additional 1,600 young people with their highly effective efforts.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

This amendment is funded with 100% Federal and State funds, and is included in the Department's FY 2011-12 Final Budget. No County General Fund match is required.
