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**ACTION REQUESTED**

Approve the appointment of Lynne Farrell to Seat #5 (representing Board of Supervisors).

**BACKGROUND**

The purpose of the Placer County Area 4 Agency on Aging Advisory Council is to serve as an advocate for senior citizens and advise the Area 4 Agency on Aging (A4AA) staff on matters related to administration and advancement of the Area Plan, including objectives and funding matters. The Council advises and makes recommendations to the A4AA Governing Board on for appropriate action on providing support and input in ascertaining the changing needs of the elderly in the member's respective counties, and facilitates communication between the counties of A4AA. The Council is comprised of five representatives from Placer County; two representatives appointed by the Board of Supervisors; two appointed by Placer County Older Adult Advisory Council; and one appointed by Nutritional Project Council. The Council meets the third Thursday of each month, with meeting locations rotating between the A4AA represented counties.
