BACKGROUND/COMMUNITY BENEFITS: In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the County and its inhabitants therefore a benefit results to the County.

The Board of Supervisors is being asked to approve appropriations to help support the Tommy Apostolos Fund “*Annual Dinner-Dance Fundraiser*” held on April 6th at the Roseville Sports Center. In 1988, in memory of Tommy Apostolos, the Apostolos Family, Roseville Police, Roseville Telephone and Roseville Elementary Schools joined together to take ten needy children shopping. This program has grown to serve hundreds of children each year from the Roseville School District. The program has afforded children the opportunity to shop for new clothes, which they could not afford to do otherwise. In the summer, and at Christmas, the children are accompanied by adult volunteers who spend \$110 per child on school and winter clothes, shoes, coats, and book bags. The funds designated towards this popular event will help offset the costs associated with this fundraising event.
