**SUBJECT:** Authorize the Registrar of Voters to Render Election Services for the Federal, State, County and Local District Elections to be held June 3, 2014

---

**Action Requested**

Approve the attached resolution authorizing the Placer County Registrar of Voters to render election services for the federal, state, county and local district elections to be held June 3, 2014.

**Background**

Pursuant to federal and state law and the Placer County charter, certain federal, state, and county elections are to be conducted by this office on the first Tuesday in June each even-numbered year.

Additionally, Election Code Section 10002 and Education Code Section 5303 provide that special district and school district governing bodies may request the Board of Supervisors to permit the Registrar of Voters to render necessary election services to the requesting districts on a reimbursable basis. For the Registrar to perform the functions pursuant to Election Code Section 10002 and Education Code Section 5303, the approval of the Board of Supervisors is required. At this time, only the Sacramento County Board of Education and Twin Rivers Unified School District, which both overlap a small portion of Placer County, have requested local district elections.

Adopting the attached resolution would authorize the Placer County Registrar of Voters to perform the requested elections and the attached 'Exhibit A' contains the full list of federal, state and local jurisdictions in Placer County requiring or requesting election services on June 3, 2014.

**Fiscal Impact**

The Sacramento County Board of Education and the Twin Rivers Unified School District will pay for the actual cost of their district elections as provided for in Election Code Section 10002 and in the approved fee schedule for election services set forth in Placer County Code Section 2.116.140.A. If the number of candidates who complete the filing process in a district election is fewer than or equal to the number of positions to be filled on the governing board, the cost to the district will be \$100. If the number of candidates who complete the filing process in a district election exceeds the number of positions to be filled, then an election will be necessary and the cost to the district should not exceed \$5,000.

WHEREAS, a primary election will be held on June 3, 2014 in order to nominate candidates to run for various federal and state offices; and

WHEREAS, the Placer County charter directs that county offices shall appear on the primary election ballot as well; and

WHEREAS, the Sacramento County Board of Education and the Twin Rivers Unified School District have ordered elections to be held in their jurisdictions on June 3, 2014; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 10002 of the Elections Code and section 5303 of the Education Code, the governing bodies of special districts and school districts may request the Placer County Board of Supervisors to permit the county elections official to render specified services to said jurisdictions relating to the conduct of elections on a reimbursable basis;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the following Federal, State, County, and District Elections be held in Placer County:
