Subject: Purchase of Body Scanner for South Placer Adult Correctional Facility

Action Requested

Authorize the Purchasing Manager to solicit bids for purchase of a Full Body Scanner for South Placer Adult Correctional Facility (SPACF), and award to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder. Additionally, authorize the Purchasing Manager to execute any related documents for the purchase in an amount not to exceed \$250,000, utilizing funds available within the Capital Project Fund (Project #4764), with no new Net County Cost.

Background

On March 12, 2013, your Board approved the purchase of a full body, X-Ray scanner for the Auburn jail to detect and prevent contraband from entering the facility.

That scanner has successfully identified multiple types of contraband including tobacco, narcotics and potential weapons. Additionally, word of this scanner has spread amongst the inmates and the amount of contraband detected within inmate housing areas has declined.

The Sheriff's Office has identified a need for a scanner within the minimum security facility at the South Placer Jail, which is scheduled for opening this fiscal year. All inmate work crews who have access to areas where concealed contraband may be located, or who demonstrate behavior that would be indicative of such activity would be scanned on site. This location would prevent introduction of contraband into the minimum security facility, and prevent minimum security inmates from transferring contraband into the secure main jail facility at South Placer.

Fiscal Impact

Upon Board approval, the Purchasing Manager will solicit bids and execute any related documents for purchase of a Full Body Scanner for SPACF in an amount not to exceed \$250,000, utilizing funds available within the Capital Project Fund (Project #4764), with no new Net County Cost.
