BACKGROUND

Nancy Nittler graduated from the University of California, Davis with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Applied Behavioral Science/Human Resources in 1984 and began her professional career with Ralph Anderson and Associates consulting firm in 1985. A retired County employee enticed Nancy to submit an application to Placer County and in 1991 she was hired as a Personnel Analyst. Nancy was quickly promoted to the Senior Personnel Analyst level in 1992 and by 1998 she was serving in the Assistant Director position. From there, Nancy promoted to the position of Director of Personnel in 1999.

During her career with the County, Nancy has served her community by volunteering with the Placer County Child Care Advisory Council and serving as a Board Member for the Auburn Rotary Club since 2005 (earning the Rotary Foundation Paul Harris Fellow award). Nancy volunteered as a Board Member for the Auburn Community Can Endowment Fund as well, and was actively involved with the Skyridge Elementary School Yearbook Committee and Auburn Mermaid Parent's Club.

In recognition of her human resource acumen, Nancy served in various capacities with professional organizations such as the International Personnel Management Association (IPMA), the County Personnel Administrators Association of California (CPAAC) and earned a professional credential from the California State Association of Counties' Institute for Excellence in County Government. Nancy was also selected to participate on the Berkeley Center for Criminal Justice/Bolt Law School advisory board on increasing employment opportunities for people with prior convictions.

As a long-time Auburn resident, Nancy and her husband Ken have raised two children in the Auburn community and continue to contribute to various philanthropic endeavors.
