**SUBJECT:** Authorize the Registrar of Voters to Render Election Services for the Federal, State, County and Local District Elections to be Held November 4, 2014

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**Action Requested**

Approve the attached resolution authorizing the Placer County Registrar of Voters to render election services for the federal, state, county and local district elections to be held November 4, 2014.

**Background**

Pursuant to federal and state law and the Placer County charter, certain federal, state, and county elections are to be conducted by this office on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November each even-numbered year.

Additionally, Election Code Section 10002 and Education Code Section 5303 provide that municipal, special district and school district governing bodies may request the Board of Supervisors to permit the Registrar of Voters to render necessary election services to the requesting districts on a reimbursable basis. For the Registrar to perform the functions pursuant to Election Code Section 10002 and Education Code Section 5303, the approval of the Board of Supervisors is required.

Adopting the attached resolution would authorize the Placer County Registrar of Voters to perform the requested elections and the attached 'Exhibit A' contains the full list of federal, state and local jurisdictions in Placer County requiring or requesting election services on November 4, 2014.

**Fiscal Impact**

Cities and districts requesting election services will reimburse the county in accordance with the approved fee schedule for such services as set forth in Placer County Code Section 2.116.140.A. If the number of candidates who complete the filing process in a city or district election is fewer than or equal to the number of positions to be filled on the governing board, the cost to the city or district will range between \$100 and \$750. If the number of candidates who complete the filing process in a city or district exceeds the number of positions to be filled and/or the city or district puts forth a measure on the ballot, then an election will be necessary and the cost to the city or district will be \$1.25 per registered voter (plus potential miscellaneous costs for some larger measures).

WHEREAS, the Placer County charter directs that county offices and measures shall appear on the general election ballot as well when necessary; and

WHEREAS, various school districts, special districts and cities have ordered elections to be held in their jurisdictions on November 4, 2014; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 10002 of the Elections Code and section 5303 of the Education Code, the governing bodies of special districts, school districts and cities may request the Placer County Board of Supervisors to permit the county elections official to render specified services to said jurisdictions relating to the conduct of elections on a reimbursable basis;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the following Federal, State, County, Municipal and District Elections be held in Placer County:
