Subject: Donation of a Mobile Water Purification System

Date: September 23, 2014

ACTION REQUESTED:

1. Accept a donation of a Mobile Water Purification System with a value of \$49,950 from Raley's and add this equipment to the Master Fixed Asset List at no net county cost.
2. Authorize the Chairman to sign the Memorandum of Understanding between Placer County and Raley's.

BACKGROUND: In coordination through the County's Office of Emergency Services (OES), Placer County has been chosen to receive a donation from Raley's of one of five Mobile Water Purification Systems. The systems are being purchased by Raley's from Global Water Group and are valued at \$49,950 each. The donated Mobile Water Purification System will be used to provide safe drinking water to local communities in times of emergency or other pressing needs in accordance with the Memorandum of Understanding with Raley's.

The Department of Facility Services has agreed to be the custodian of the Mobile Water Purification System as its staff hold California licenses for drinking water treatment and distribution and are responsible for the operation and maintenance of two drinking water systems. Facilities Services also has the necessary auxiliary equipment, such as tow vehicles and portable generators, necessary to transport and power the Mobile Water Purification System.

In the event this equipment is deployed, OES and Facility Services will coordinate with the HHS Division of Environmental Health Division (DEH) to ensure water sources being used are appropriate. Additionally, DEH will provide technical support to ensure the protection of public health in the event this equipment is used to provide potable water. Use of this equipment by agencies other than the County will be coordinated by OES to ensure compliance with applicable mutual aid agreements that include provisions for reimbursement of the cost of operation of the mobile water purification equipment and any auxiliary equipment. Acceptance of this equipment will add to the County's capability to respond in local emergencies and to assist others agencies with mutual aid in regional events that affect water availability.

ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE: The acceptance of the donation of a Mobile Water Purification System is not considered a project under the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to Section 15378 of the CEQA Guidelines.

FISCAL IMPACT: Acquisition of the Mobile Water Purification System is being paid by Raley's. Cost for emergency use of the unit will be paid by the agency that uses the unit. The cost of maintenance for the Mobile Water Purification System will be minimal and will be absorbed in the Environmental Utilities budget.

Memorandum of Understanding

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between Raley's and Sacramento County OES, El Dorado County OES, Placer County OES, Contra Costa County OES and Sonoma County Water Agency reflects the parties understanding as follows:

1. Raley's agrees to provide each recipient listed above with one 20 gallons per minute Water Purification Trailer (Trailer), at no cost to each recipient (see attachment of trailer specifications).
2. The Trailers are being provided to assist these communities during emergencies where the supply of drinking water may be limited, unavailable, or untreated. Each recipient will become the owner of record eligible for any manufacturer's warranty and will be responsible for any associated registration, license, and insurance.
3. Each recipient agrees to: store the Trailer, maintain the Trailer in good working order, and make the Trailer available within their county to other local governments, jurisdictions, or municipalities.
4. If requested under mutual aid/mutual assistance, each recipient will make the Trailer available in accordance with terms and conditions of the applicable mutual aid agreement (CA MMAA, CalWARN, etc). The recipients are not obligated under this letter of understanding to provide an operator with the Trailer.
5. The five trailers will be delivered to Sacramento County OES Facility at 3720 Dudley Blvd, McClellan CA. The manufacture (Global Water Group) will provide a 2-3 hour seminar on the use and maintenance of the trailers, instructional guides, and all operating manuals (see attachment of training outline). Raley's obligation with respect to provision of these trailers ends with this delivery.
6. Each recipient will be responsible to take possession of its Trailer at the Sacramento County EOS Facility. Upon taking possession, each recipient will own and be solely responsible for its respective Trailer and for the transportation of the Trailer to their county for storage and use.



