PUBLIC COMMITTEE

PURPOSE: To aid and assist the Planning Department and Planning Commission in matters of design within the area shown on Exhibit A of establishing Res. 2001-223. All recommendations by the Committee shall be advisory only and final decisions are to be made by the Planning Department, Zoning Administrator, Board of Zoning Appeals, Planning Commission or Board of Supervisors.
