**Background**

On November 4, 2014, the County Clerk-Recorder-Registrar of Voters conducted the Gubernatorial General Election in and for the voters of Placer County. After every election, the County Clerk-Recorder-Registrar of Voters has 28 days to conduct the post-election canvass and certify the official results.

On December 1, 2014, the Placer County Elections Office certified the election results and completed the official Placer County statement of vote, the document that details the individuals elected and the measures decided at the November 4, 2014 Gubernatorial General Election. In accordance with California Elections Code section 15400, upon completion of the canvass your Board of Supervisors, as the governing body of the jurisdiction, has the duty to declare elected or nominated the individuals having received the highest number of votes within the jurisdiction and to declare the results of measures voted in within the jurisdiction.
