BACKGROUND/COMMUNITY BENEFITS

The Board of Supervisors is being asked to approve appropriations to *The Lincoln Theatre Company* to help with the enhancements to the Historic Lincoln Civic Auditorium. The Lincoln Theatre Company's mission is to produce adult and youth community theater, provide performing arts education opportunities for both children and adults, showcase local talent, and bring an enjoyable educational and theatrical experience to the community.
