**BACKGROUND/COMMUNITY BENEFITS:**

In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the County and its inhabitants therefore a benefit results to the County.

The Board of Supervisors is being asked to approve appropriations for the KidsFirst annual Blue Tie Affair fundraising event to be held on April 16, 2015. Since its inception in 1989, KidsFirst has provided child abuse prevention services to more than fifty thousand children. KidsFirst is dedicated to helping parents with difficult life situations before circumstances become overwhelming and a child is hurt. With a focus on promoting the health and well-being of children, KidsFirst provides health insurance enrollment assistance, coaching and support for parents, therapeutic services for children and grown-ups, youth activities, family events, information, and referrals to countless community resources. The funding received will be used for family resource centers and counseling programs designed to serve young children and teens who have suffered from any form of child abuse and/or neglect.
