**BACKGROUND/COMMUNITY BENEFITS:**

In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the County and its inhabitants therefore a benefit results to the County.

The Board of Supervisors is being asked to approve appropriations to help support the *Placer People of Faith Together/Growing Peace Camp* program during the week of August 3<sup>rd</sup> – August 7<sup>th</sup> at the Alta Vista Charter School in Auburn. The Placer People of Faith Together (PPOFT) has been operating in the Auburn area for the past 28 plus years as a grass-roots community-based program. The program provides an alternative day camp experience for children age 5 to 11, and a counselor-in-training program for teens age 13 to 17 from diverse ethnic, economic and cultural backgrounds, including those who may be at risk or low income.

The program provides an alternative day camp experience that fosters an understanding of peace, justice and environmental awareness. Through the use of art, music, drama, dance, discussion and care for the local environment, development of self-esteem, empowerment, critical thinking skills, and the ability to initiate change (activism) towards a more peaceful community is encouraged. Funding received will be used to pay for supplies, printing costs, background screening of volunteers, and camp T-shirts.
