BACKGROUND/COMMUNITY BENEFITS:

In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the County and its inhabitants therefore a benefit results to the County.

The Board of Supervisors is being asked to approve appropriations to help support the Roseville Chamber's 20th Annual SPLASH event to be held on September 12th at the Roseville Aquatics Center. This annual event features more than thirty wineries and breweries, a dozen artists and nearly thirty local restaurants and caterers. SPLASH is an evening of art, food, and wine enjoyed by a sell-out crowd of more than 1,100 local residents each year.
