WHEREAS, a Storm Drain Easement was dedicated to Placer County on the map of Alpine Meadows Estates Subdivision, Unit No 6, filed for record in Book I of Maps at Page 19, and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the portion of the Storm Drain Easement on Lot 198, as described on the attached Exhibit "A" and as shown on the attached Exhibit "B", is no longer necessary for present or prospective public use, and

WHEREAS, summary vacation of the easement is permissible pursuant to Chapter 4 of Part 3, Division 9 of the Streets and Highways Code, commencing with Section 8330

DESCRIPTION

Being a portion of the property described in the deed to Paul Warner and Susana Cordero, in the grant deed recorded June 4, 2014 in Document No 20014-0036609, Official Records of Placer County, also being a portion of Lot 198, as shown on the Alpine Meadows Estates Subdivision Unit No. 6, as filed in Book I of Maps at Page 19, Official Records of Placer County, California, said parcel being located in Section 4, Township 15 North, Range 16 East, M.D.B & M , and more particularly as described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the northwesterly line of a 40 foot wide Storm Drain Easement as shown on the Alpine Meadows Estates Subdivision Unit No. 6, as filed in Book I of Maps at Page 19, Official Records of Placer County, California, which bears North 53°57'42" East, 9.40 feet from the intersection of the northwesterly line of the storm drainage easement and the westerly line of said Lot 198, as shown on said subdivision map; thence from said point of beginning the following six (6) courses.

- 1) along the northwesterly line of said easement, North 53°57'42" East, 5.85 feet;
- 2) departing said easement line, North 83°40'47" East, 19.92 feet;
- 3) South 06°19'13" East, 12.17 feet,
- 4) South 35°40'47" West, 12.34 feet,
- 5) South 83°40'47" East, 16.75 feet,
- 6) North 06°19'13" West, 18.43 feet, more or less to the point of beginning

Above described Storm Drain Easement Abandonment contains 488 feet, more or less

The bearings used in this document are based upon those shown on the Alpine Meadows Estates Subdivision Unit No. 6, as filed in Book I of Maps at Page 19, Official Records of Placer County, California

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
