BACKGROUND/COMMUNITY BENEFITS

In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the County and its inhabitants therefore a benefit results to the County.

Dry Creek Conservancy was formed in 1996. It is a collaborative engine for healthy natural systems in our communities with a focus on watersheds. The conservancy organizes projects and processes such as native plantings, salmon barrier removal, and monthly collaborative meetings that provide the community with opportunities to come together as partners. The funds designated will be used for the teaching materials for the Low Impact Development Regional Conference whose goal is to increase effectiveness of local impact development practices by stimulating dialogue among developers, engineers, planners, regulators, and local governments.
