

WHEREAS, The Agricultural Commissioner is responsible for preventing the introduction and spread of harmful invasive pests, and

WHEREAS, Invasive weeds are detrimental to agriculture, forest lands and the environment, and

WHEREAS, Placer County's forests provide recreational, scenic, ecological and economic benefits, and

WHEREAS, Early detection and rapid response to invasive weed infestations is an effective way to promote forest and watershed health, and

WHEREAS, The California Department of Food and Agriculture proposes to contract with Placer County for the purpose of offsetting the costs of detecting and eradicating invasive weeds on and near non-federal forest lands

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, THAT:

The Board of Supervisors authorizes and directs the Agricultural Commissioner/Sealer to sign cooperative agreement #15-0442-SF in the amount of \$25,234 with the California Department of Food and Agriculture for reimbursement for invasive weed control conducted on and near non-federal properties near forested lands (USFS State & Private Forestry) from July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2017
