**SUBJECT:** North Lake Tahoe Region Transportation Update

---

**Action Requested**

Receive a presentation on status of and planned improvements to Placer County's transportation systems in the North Lake Tahoe region.

**Background**

Placer County provides and funds a wide array of transportation services in the North Lake Tahoe Region, including operation of the TART bus system, capital projects such as bridge construction and repair, bike trails, sidewalks, road maintenance and snow plowing.

In the North Lake Tahoe Region specifically, these projects and services are planned, funded and implemented within a complex, multi-jurisdictional regulatory framework with multiple funding sources and implementation partnerships with local, state and federal agencies, as well as the private sector. This presentation mirrors a similar discussion with the Tahoe Regional Governing Board last month, which set the context for Placer County's significant investment in multi-modal transportation that links the Tahoe basin to adjacent resort communities and urbanized northern California and Nevada, and plans for additional investment in the future.

**Fiscal Impact**

There is no fiscal impact. The plans, services and capital projects described are either included in the current County budget, or part of longer term capital and program planning, which would be funded through future grants, fees and budget allocations to projects.
