SUBJECT: Approve the request of the School Facilities Improvement District No. 1 and No. 2 of the Western Placer Unified School District for an All Mail Ballot Special Election and authorize the County Clerk to render reimbursed election services.

Action Requested

Approve the attached resolution calling a May 3, 2016 All Mail Ballot Special District Election as requested by the School Facilities Improvement District No. 1 and No. 2 of the Western Placer Unified School District, authorizing the County Clerk to render reimbursed election services for the District.

Background

Election Code Section 10002 provides that the governing body of any district may by resolution request the Board of Supervisors to conduct their elections and permit the County Clerk to render necessary election services to the district on a reimbursable basis.

The School Facilities Improvement District No. 1 and No. 2 of the Western Placer Unified School District on January 5, 2016, adopted a resolution by their governing board, requesting the Placer County Clerk to conduct a May 3, 2016 All Mail Ballot Special District Election for the District.

In order for the Placer County Clerk to perform the election functions requested by the School Facilities Improvement District No. 1 and No. 2 of the Western Placer Unified School District pursuant to Elections Code Sections 10002, 10403 and 1500, the County Clerk must have the approval of your Board.

Fiscal Impact

The School Facilities Improvement District No. 1 and No. 2 of the Western Placer Unified School District will pay for the actual cost of their district election as provided for in Election Code Section 10002 and in the approved fee schedule for election services set forth in Placer County Code Section 2.116.140.A.

WHEREAS, the School Facilities Improvement District No. 1 and No. 2 of the Western Placer Unified School District has ordered an All Mail Ballot Special District Election to be held in its jurisdiction on May 3, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the wording for said measure has been delivered to the County Clerk and is presented to the Placer County Board of Supervisors as Exhibit A (see attached); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 10002, 10405 and 1500 of the Elections Code, the Governing Body of the District may request the Placer County Board of Supervisors to call elections and permit the county elections official to render specified services to said Body relating to the conduct of elections on a reimbursable basis; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Placer County Board of Supervisors that the School Facilities Improvement District No. 1 and No. 2 of the Western Placer Unified School District All Mail Ballot Special Election shall be held on May 3, 2016; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Placer hereby authorizes the Placer County Registrar of Voters to render any and all necessary election services to the District.

EXHIBIT A

Measure A – School Facilities Improvement District No. 1 of the Western Placer Unified School District

To construct new middle and high school facilities and acquire land to accommodate growing student enrollment and avoid overcrowding to support high academic achievement, shall the School Facilities Improvement District No. 1 (Village 1, Zone A) of Western Placer Unified School District incur bonded indebtedness of not to exceed \$175,000,000 with interest rates below legal limits and no money for salaries or other routine school operating expenses with all money raised benefiting local students?

Measure B – School Facilities Improvement District No. 2 of the Western Placer Unified School District

To construct new elementary, middle and high school facilities and acquire land to accommodate growing student enrollment and avoid overcrowding to support high academic achievement, shall the School Facilities Improvement District No. 2 (Village 7, Zone B) of the Western Placer Unified School District incur bonded indebtedness of not to exceed \$215,000,000 with interest rate below legal limits and no money for salaries or other routine school operating expenses with all money raised benefiting local students?
