SUBJECT: Board of Supervisors Meeting – March 8, 2016

ACTION REQUESTED

Adopt a resolution authorizing the Placer County Registrar of Voters to render election services for the election to be held June 7, 2016.

BACKGROUND

Pursuant to federal and state law and the Placer County charter, certain federal, state, and county elections are to be conducted by this office on the first Tuesday in June each even-numbered year. Election Code Section 1002, 1202, 10002 and Education Code Section 5303 also provide that special district and school Governing Bodies may request the Board of Supervisors to order their elections and permit the County Clerk to render necessary election services to said Bodies on a reimbursable basis. For the County Clerk to perform the functions pursuant to Election Code Section 10002 and Education Code Section 5303, the County Clerk needs approval of this resolution from the Board of Supervisors.

FISCAL IMPACT

Requesting jurisdictions will pay for these special elections based on the approved fee schedule for election services.

Measure C – Placer Union High School District

(Placer County only)

Requires 55% to pass

To improve Colfax, Del Oro, Foresthill, Placer, Chana and Maidu high schools, and Placer Adult School by renovating/constructing classrooms/educational facilities including Career Technical Education and Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, Math (STEAM); and upgrading/replacing emergency systems, technology infrastructure electrical, plumbing, HVAC, and roofing; shall Placer Union High School District issue \$135 million of bonds with interest rates below legal limits, no funds for teacher/administrator salaries, and citizen oversight guaranteeing funds spent only on our local schools?
