ACTION REQUESTED

Approve appropriation of \$250 in Revenue Sharing monies to Kindred Spirits Fawn Rescue for wildlife rescue and rehabilitation efforts and for continuation of educational outreach.

BACKGROUND

In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the County and its inhabitants therefore a benefit results to the County.


The Board of Supervisors is being asked to approve appropriations to Kindred Spirits Fawn Rescue. This non-profit organization rescues, rehabilitates, and releases injured wildlife (fawns) throughout Placer County. Kindred Spirits Fawn Rescue supports Placer County Animal Control with responding to deer or fawn related calls. In 2015, this organization's volunteers rescued and released 191 fawns back into the wild. They also provide educational outreach programs to local children teaching them how to respect and protect animals. The funds will be used to support rescue and rehabilitation efforts.

Kindred Spirits Fawn Rescue received 2259 calls from the Placer County residents in 2015 regarding injured/orphaned fawns & deer. We are routed all the deer/fawn calls coming in to Placer Animal Control and have become the 1st responders freeing up the officers to focus on domestic calls. We also respond to Placer County Sherriff's needs in assisting on wildlife calls. Our yearly school outreach program educates the local grade school children about our local wildlife & how to respect and live in harmony with them. Our organization rescue 191 fawns in 2015 which were rehabilitated and released back into the wild.
